Message from EVP Dana Taylor

New Horizons – Lower Dues & Do More!

Big news: MCABC has lowered most Voting Contractor dues. In 78 years of operation, MCABC has been funded by various methods: individual membership dues, to grants from union contractors' collective agreements, to the current structure where dues are

based on company payroll.

LOWER DUES But this is the first time - to my knowledge - that dues have gone down! For all but one category of payroll volume membership, dues have been reduced from 5%

to almost 29%. Why did the dues rates change? The simple answer is we want more contractors to join. Our fees were unaffordable to some contractors, so we reduced them.

Mechanical contractors:

You are responsible for estimating for, and supplying, sheet metal shields and hangers in certain cases

Mechanicals need to be aware of installation requirements where continuous vapour barrier is required on cold water piping systems

Dated August 20, 2018, the following update to the BC Insulation Contractors Association Quality Standards Manual was provided to MCABC by the BC Insulation Contractors Association (BCICA) Technical Committee:

- a) Where a continuous vapour barrier is required, Insulation Contractors include for Crush Proof Insulation at Hanger / Support locations for piping 2-1/2" and larger unless specified otherwise. Sheet Metal Shields are NOT included and shall be the responsibility of the Mechanical Contractor.
- b) Where the use of Pre-manufactured or Engineered Insulation Systems are specified for Hangers / Supports, they are NOT included and shall the responsibility of the Mechanical Contractor.
