Have a say in proposed changes to Code Canada publications

The National Research Council of Canada's public review of national model construction codes is open until 4 pm **March 13, 2020**. Members are encouraged to reference the proposed changes to the following Code Canada publications and provide feedback:

- National Building Code of Canada 2015 (NBC)
- National Fire Code of Canada 2015 (NFC)
- National Energy Code of Canada for Buildings 2017 (NECB)
- Updates to the documents referenced in the 2015 and 2017 National Model Codes

These changes will form the basis of the 2020 National Model Codes. The B.C. Building, Plumbing and Fire Codes (B.C. Codes) are based substantially on the model Codes Canada publications. **Changes to the Codes Canada publications are typically adopted into the B.C. Codes.**
