



In response to the BC Law Institute's *Consultation Paper on the Builders Lien Act (BLA),* MCABC shared on behalf of members, its concern that Prompt Payment and payment dispute adjudication were not part of the update to the BLA, which provides an ideal framework for both. While MCABC supports the much-needed update to the BLA, we are concerned that Prompt Payment was considered "out of scope". As part of our response, MCABC reinforced the importance of legislation for prompt payment which we would expect would be incorporated as part of a legal regime that is enforceable alongside the BLA until such time that both are integrated.
