





#### Bill 23 to Alter Schedule 1 of Workers Compensation Act

Despite our efforts in collaboration with the larger business community, WorkSafeBC has added infections caused by communicable viral pathogens, including COVID-19, to the list of diseases presumed to have been contracted at work. The change will come into effect on October 26. 2020 or earlier – the BC Legislature may pass Bill 23 prior to that date. For additional information:
