Metro Vancouver is proposing changes to the Boilers and Process Heaters Emissions Regulation Bylaw 1087

Metro Vancouver wants to hear from you on the <u>proposed amendments to Bylaw 1087</u>, which regulates the discharge of air contaminants such as nitrogen oxides (NOx) from boilers and process heaters that may affect some buildings and industrial facilities in the Metro Vancouver region. The changes aim to support continuous improvement to regional ambient air quality and the protection of human health.

The proposed amendments include:

- More stringent emission limits for NOx that might require upgrades or replacement of boilers and process heaters
- Additional dispersion modelling requirements to demonstrate achievement of ambient air quality objectives
- Additional requirements for emission stack design to reduce nearby impacts

A <u>discussion paper</u> describes the rationale and outlines the proposed amendments.

Metro Vancouver welcomes input from interested and affected parties. An <u>online feedback</u> form is available and will remain open until November 30, 2022. Feedback will be considered in fine-tuning the proposed bylaw amendments for consideration by Metro Vancouver Board of Directors.
